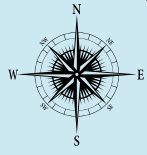


Key Rohingya Displacement Updates

Feran Furu Crossing Point

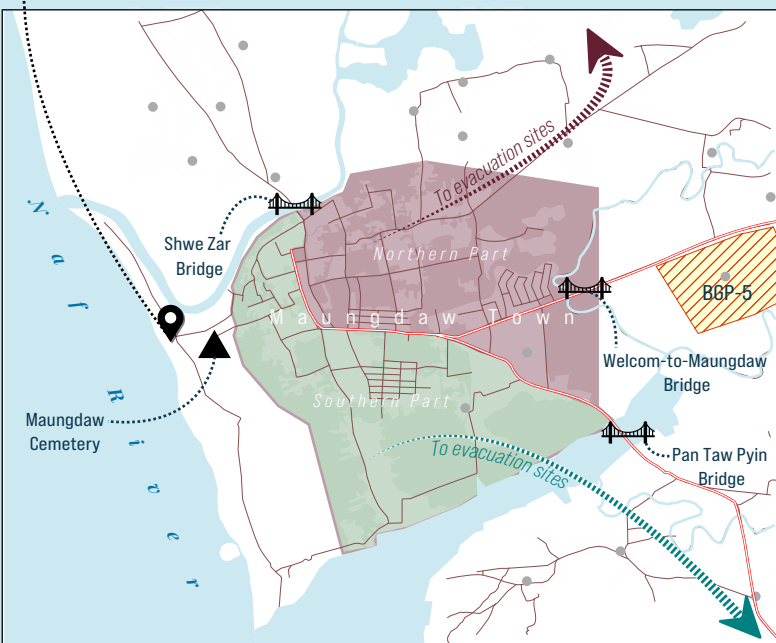
'Feran Furu (Mingalar Gyi - Pyin Hpyu)' and 'Mangla (Tha Yet Oke)' are two well-known border crossing points for crossing the Naf River into Bangladesh. Many Rohingya are taking shelter in nearby villages.

China Fatti

"China Fatti" is an area to the west of Maungdaw Town. It is the site of recent drone attacks that killed many Rohingya who were fleeing Maungdaw Town and trying to cross the Naf River into Bangladesh.

● **Hla Poe Khaung Camp**
Approximately 1,500 Rohingya are taking shelter at the 'Hla Poe Khaung Transit Camp'.

● Rohingya people are leaving their temporary evacuation sites and heading to border crossing points to flee to Bangladesh.
